- B→Stabil Grotesk, the dependable sibling imbued with a workhorse quality; though not shy of its distinctly fine-tuned eccentricities.

The juxtaposition of the balance inherent in sans-serif letterforms and the notion of text being affected by the laws of gravity is a central theme in KOMETA's first release.

The origin of Labil Grotesk goes back to a typeface done as a master's thesis project nominated for Czech National Award for Student Design 2016. Encouraged by the reception, Christian Jánký set out to remaster the whole family—leaving the concept intact. After 3 years of development, it is finally available in 5 weights (Thin–Bold) with a myriad of alternates conveniently categorised into 8 stylistic sets.

What started out as a first foray into typeface design evolved into a comprehensive sans-serif family of 10 multilingual fonts—supporting Latin Extended-A, i.e. Western European, Central European & Southeastern European languages—plus a wealth of contextual alternates, bonus glyphs and case-sensitive forms easily accessible via OpenType.
